

3 To make the tails, cut out the tails using the pattern provided, making the second reversed, and positioning any pattern carefully so that the two halves match. Cut out a 15cm (6in) long by 25mm (1in) wide strip of lining. Lay a strip of fusible webbing along the angled bottom edge of each tail and lay the lining over it. Iron to bond the lining to the tail and trim the lining to match the tail. Glue fringe along the back of the diagonal edge of each tail.

4 Press back the side seams on each tail. Fold each tail along the fold lines and press firmly, holding each fold in place with a dab of PVA glue.





5 Glue the tails over the swag, gluing the top edge of each to the top of the pelmet with the sides of the tail curving around the sides of the pelmet. Fold the excess fabric at the top neatly under and glue down.
