

Grand Designs

The illustration shows how you can make a completely different look by reversing the patterned fabric and plain lining. Full-length curtains in the same yellow silk as the swag and tails make a sumptuous display that would be suitable for a Victorian or modern room. The swag is arranged over the tails in this design and is finished off with two polymer clay roundels.



1 Make the full-length curtains, swag and tails in yellow silk.

2 Drape one of the curtains for a tie-back and attach a tie-back made from pale blue cord.

3 Use pale blue patterned cotton to line the tails (this fabric could also be used to make cushions or other upholstered pieces in the room).

4 Trim the tails with matching pale blue ribbon and attach pale blue tassels to their ends. Glue the tails to the pelmet, and glue the swag over the tails.

5 Make two polymer clay roundels, painted gold (see page 54 for instructions) and glue them to the top corners of the swag. Glue the whole assemblage to the dolls' house window.
