

Soft and Exotic

This alternative to the Elaborate Curtains would be suitable for a Regency or Victorian dolls' house and has a valance instead of a swag below a white and gold cornice.

1 Cut a piece of cornice to length and glue a piece of 10mm (3/8in) wide lace to the front. Paint the cornice and lace with white acrylic paint and, when dry, pick out the detail of the lace in gold paint to suggest an elaborate moulding.

3 Drape to the left for a tie-back and attach a matching tie-back.

2 Cut out and make a single full-length curtain, half as wide again as the window. Trim the right side and bottom with gold fringe and gather it up to fit the width of the window.

4 Make a valance using the pattern from the Valance Curtains project on page 42 and trim with gold fringe.

5 Assemble the curtains and cornice with two gold tassels hanging down on the right side. Glue the whole assembly to the dolls' house window.
