

## Candy Dish Tutorials

Okay I have two to give you.

One is real easy and the other is just easy.

### Button Candy Dish 1

#### Materials

Three buttons decreasing in size slightly with at least 2 holes

(I used black)

One twist tie in matching colour or contrasting color

Bead or jewelry finding for base.

#### Steps

Fold twist tie in half forming a loop. Twist twice.

Push ends through holes of first button and twist three times.

Push ends through holes of second button and twist three times.

Push ends through holes of last button and twist and fold over.

You can add a bit of glue to secure if you wish.

Glue your base, bead or jewelry finding to the under side of the

Third button covering the ends of the twist tie.

Let dry, one candy dish.

I told you it was simple.



### Candy dish 2

#### Materials

Two small silver trays that hold make up. (without the makeup)

Small bead

Jewelry finding or bead for base (I used 3 medium snaps and a button)

Paperclip

Nail or something to punch small hole in trays

Glue (white or super glue)

#### Steps

Unfold your paper clip until fairly straight.

Make a small triangle or circle shaped handle

Set aside

Punch one small hole in the center of each tray

Insert your small bead on to the paper clip and push up to the handle end.
